

Bank On Wayne Volunteer Tutors

Literacy Connections is looking for two volunteer tutors to facilitate small group instruction for our financial literacy program, Bank On Wayne. Volunteers must be at least 18 years old, and read, write and speak English well. No prior teaching experience required, but extensive knowledge of banking and credit are a must. A background in banking would be ideal.

All prospective tutors are required to complete an initial two hour training session, followed by two hours of shadowing and observation. This training will introduce tutors to the purpose and goals of the Bank On program. Tutors will also be introduced to the FDIC Money Smart material that will be presented in the workshops.

Tutors will be responsible for preparing materials and delivering engaging instruction using the Money Smart curriculum. Tutors are needed for morning, afternoon and evening workshops at various locations in the community.

All supplies and materials will be provided by Literacy Connections. Bank On Wayne is a United Way of Wayne County partner program.
